We are holding this Circle Conference on the sidelines of our All India Conference jointly hosted by us with Tamil Nadu Circle Association at RGM TTC, Chennai.

In this inspiring occasion I would like to present this Report for the period June 2015 to January 2019.

After the Circle Conferences we have held three CECs on 23-4-16, 04-02-17 and 21-4-18. The CECs deliberated the service issues related to members, Organisational matters and have guided the Circle Body on important issues. The CECs have also used the occasions to felicitate our retiring Comrades.

Even before the Circle Conference, the ad hoc body successfully led our members in the two days All India Strike of all Unions and Associations on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 2015 as directed by our All India Conference, Calcutta a few days earlier. This strike was a great success not only in Chennai but also throughout India.

Contrasting this with the two days strike call on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> of December 2017, which was not endorsed by our Association, the general mood of the employees and executives was not enthusiastic. Our stand on the timing and method of this strike was generally appreciated and accepted by the Employees and Executives of BSNL. In this strike when all the Offices and Exchanges were forcibly closed and no one was allowed to enter the workplaces, our circle union properly guided the members what is to be done and recorded our nonparticipation and stopped the pay cut that was to be done by the CH TD administration to our members.

We participated in the CWCs at Jaipur on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 and Lucknow on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of September 2019.

Between the two CECs was the first Membership verification for Executive Associations in BSNL.

We met each and every executive individually and campaigned for the Association. We brought out posters and a small handout explaining the positions of our association in various issues and the issues taken up and resolve by us. Even though the executives generally accepted that ours is the only Association with reasonableness, openness and unbiased approach to the issues, Association Loyalty made a big score and all members voted either to the associations in which they were members or to the election alliance in which their associations were part of.

We could get 55 votes in Chennai Telephones against the powerful alliance of AIBSNLEA and the traditionally strong SNEA.

Regarding the Strike Call given by AUBA in December 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> last, a detailed report has been given in our All India Conference and in depth deliberations are taking place and I would like not to create redundancy in this report.

We are constantly in touch with our members and taking up their issues with the Administration. Issues like LA arrangements, Time bound promotions and local transfers are taken up are being solved as a regular and continuous work.

Recently we have taken up the case of request transfer of our members Shanthi AO and Bhuvanewari AO and have got them their choice of place.

At this juncture, we would like to place our thanks to our CHQ and our GS Com

Sethi who has always given us the confidence and strength with this support. Com Sethi and Com RRB keep inspiring us with their honest and dedicated work.

Our CHQ has been supportive of our position in the following cases and helped us by taking up the case at Corporate Office Level

Continued Retention of Com Thirumaran AO in Chennai first in temporary phases and later a permanent cancellation the transfer order.

Retention in Chennai TD, Com Usha Rajam on promotion as DE

Retention in Chennai TD, Com Nandakumar on promotion as DE

Inter circle request transfers of Comrades Palayathan DE, Com Murali DE, Com Chandrasekar DE and Com Kamalini DE.

Deferment of transfer of Com Jayachandran SDE on Hard tenure to North East Circle.

We could reverse a transfer order of CHTD issued to Com V Anbarasan SDE on tenure to Chengelpattu SSA.

On behalf of all Executives of BSNL, we place on record our thanks to our CHQ for continuously maintaining our position very clear on Executive promotions without falling prey to any diversionary ideas. Our position on regular promotions of our executives deprived of justified aspirations has been proved correct and our persistent efforts have brought the massive promotions witnessed by us recently. We hope bottlenecks in regular promotions in other left out cadres also will be achieved shortly.

Finally I conclude my report by thanking all members of AIBSNLOA CHTD for their continued support to our Association and their dedicated participation in all programmes and meetings called by us. Special thanks to our Circle Office Bearers for their help and support and our President Com P Ramachandran who has been a guiding force for the functioning of our Circle Body.
